

## Vocabulary for Poetry

- Title of Poem
- Poet (writer of poem)
- End stopped Line – Lines of poetry with some form of punctuation
- Run-on Line – Lines of poetry with no punctuation at the end
- Rhyme - verse or poetry having the same sound at the end of lines.  
*Twinkle, twinkle, little star,  
How I wonder what you are!  
Up above the world so high,  
Like a diamond in the sky.*
- Rhythm - the pattern of regular or irregular beats caused in music or poetry  
*Jack and Jill went up the hill to fetch a pail of water  
Jack fell down and broke his crown and  
Jill came tumbling after.*
